WINTER SAFARI 2024/5

The winter safari will be based in Dunfermline City centre moving from Pittencrieff Park to Dunfermline Public Park. The photos can be taken in any order but must be sorted in the order below starting with photo 01 and finishing with the team photo 36.

The team photo can be taken anywhere (not necessarily during the safari) but must have a PANTO theme. Creative editing is encouraged. Photos can be in mono or colour unless stated in the instructions.

Where possible WHAT THREE WORDS will be used to provide an approximate location.

There are plenty of cafe opportunities for certain teams.

PHOTO 01 - Starting at the Seven Kings (fires.boring.spoil) take a photo of the Louise Carnegie (Pittencrieff Park) gates (include the Xmas tree if it is still present).

PHOTO 02 - Take a photo of a detail of the park gates.

PHOTO 03 - Moving into the park take a photo of the Carnegie statue (sorry.calculating.excuse)

PHOTO 04 - Take a photo of the dovecot (complains.closet.drill).

PHOTO 05 - Take a photo of the Peace Pole sited to the south of the Glen Pavilion. (close to (sizes.cool.lower).

PHOTO 06 - Take a photo of the Old Telephone Kiosk - you may remove the identification notice (gained.exam.invest).

PHOTO 07 - Move to the Italian Garden and take a photo of the fountain in the pool. (giant.select.gains)

PHOTO 08 - Take a photo of the over bridge close to the toilet block (oval.elder.lately)

PHOTO 09 - While in the park take a photo of any tree/s in colour.

PHOTO 10 - Take a photo of any tree/s but in mono.

PHOTO 11 - Head out of the park towards the Abbey. Take a photo of the Abbey from within the park. (ears.family.snaps)

PHOTO 12 - Take a photo of the Palace ruins (engine.slip.notion).

PHOTO 13 - Head into the Abbey grounds and take a photo of the Abbey to include a/some grave stone/s (thank.solar.scuba).

PHOTO 14 - While in the Abbey Grounds take a photo of the Priory ruins (chase.format.firms).

PHOTO 15 - Heading to the east exit turn right. Head down to the Carnegie Museum and take a photo of the museum (barn.breed.purple).

PHOTO 16 - Head back up to the Library/museum and take a phot of any aspect of the building (bland.cloth.mime).

PHOTO 17 - Take a photo of the Tam o'Shanter statues in the Museum grounds (dragon.trying.future).

PHOTO 18 - Head along Abbot Street and take a photo of Abbot House (fuzzy.energy wanted).

PHOTO 19 - Head up to the City Chambers and take a photo of the clock tower (hardly. soaks.parent).

PHOTO 20 The City Chambers has several architectural features. Take three or more images of the features and create a montage/triptych.

PHOTO 21 - Take a photo of Bridge Street looking west to the park gates.

PHOTO 22 - Take a photo of Bruce Street.

PHOTO 23 - Head east and take a photo of the High Street.

PHOTO 24 - Take a photo looking down Guildhall Street (sweep.prove.precautions).

PHOTO 25 - Take a photo of the Guildhall & Linen Exchange (now Wetherspoons). (winter.wings.secure)

PHOTO 26 - Continue east and take a photo looking down the New Row (dusty.librarian.legs).

PHOTO 27 - Head down the New Row and take a photo of the Alhambra (silver.idea.leap).

PHOTO 28 - While at the Alhambra take a Photo of the British Legion Club (chats.train.alert).

PHOTO 29 - Head back up the New Row and turn right onto Eastport. Take a photo looking along Eastport.

PHOTO 30 - Continue east and take a photo of the three churches (Holy Trinity church, St Margarets parish church and Viewfield Baptist church). Create a triptych/ montage of the 3 churches.

PHOTO 31 - Continue east and take a photo of the Carnegie Hall (answer.owners.song).

PHOTO 32 - Take a photo of the adjoining Arts and Theatre Trust building (frame.skips.either).

PHOTO 33 - Head east into (via the pedestrian bridge) Dunfermline Public Park and take a photo of the fountain (answer.froze.oils).

PHOTO 34 - Take a general view of the Park in colour.

PHOTO 35 - Take a general view of the park in MONO.

PHOTO 36 - TEAM PHOTO - don't forget the PANTO theme.
